## 10 things to know about Nick Foles

- 1 Was the seventh quarterback selected in the 2012 draft, the 88th player picked overall.
- 2 Is married to his college sweetheart, Tori Moore. They have three dogs and a cat.
- **3** Had right shoulder surgery in high school performed by renowned Dr. James Andrews.
- **4** Had a 50.5 rating in the first half last week against Jacksonville. Boasted it to 129.7 as the Eagles outscored the Jags, 34-0, after halftime
- **5** Wrote a research paper on John Elway while in elementary school. Wore No. 7 in high school because of Elway.
- **6** Oddly, wore No. 8 at the University of Arizona and wears No. 9 for the Eagles.
- **7** Was a high school teammate of Ravens kicker Justin Tucker. The school, Westlake in Austin, Texas, also produced Drew Brees.
- **8** Set the Eagles rookie records for passing yards (1,699) in 2012. John Reaves (1,508) had held the mark since 1972.
- **9** Threw two interceptions at Washington in 2012 in his first career road start. In seven road starts since, Foles has thrown 21 touchdowns, just one interception and won five of those games.
- **10** Foles is starting his 19th game on Monday. It will be his sixth in prime-time. The Eagles are 2-3 in the previous five.

## 10 things to know about Andrew Luck

- 1 Signed a 4-year, \$22.1 million contract as a rookie in 2012.
- **2** Set the rookie record with 433 passing yards against Miami on Nov. 4, 2012. Foles established the Eagles' mark with 381 yards at Tampa Bay on Dec. 9, 2012.
- **3** This will be Luck's first start against an NFC East team.
- 4 Had a 3.48 GPA at Stanford and majored in architectural design.
- **5** His 3,822 passing yards in 2012 broke Cam Newton's rookie record and his 8,196 yards in his first two seasons also is an NFL record.
- **6** His quarterbacks coach, Clyde Christensen, coached QBs and wide receivers for Temple from 1983-85.
- 7 Indy offensive coordinator Pep Hamilton was Luck's OC at Stanford.
- **8** Finished second in Heisman voting to Newton in 2010 and Robert Griffin III in 2011.
- **9** Lived in the same building at Stanford as Michelle Wie.
- **10** His father, Oliver, was a reserve quarterback for the Houston Oilers from 1983-86. He is currently the athletic director for West Virginia University and a member of college football's new playoff selection committee.
