This graph shows how the makes rank based on average predicted reliability scores, and which models by each make have the highest and lowest ratings. The score is the overall reliability calculated as a percentage better or worse than the average for all cars. The rank order change from our 2011 survey compared with last year's is noted as well. Large changes are highlighted.
