

NEW NFL FAN CODE OF CONDUCT

Announced earlier last month, the NFL has the right to eject fans from stadiums and bar them from coming back for the following offenses:

- Behavior that is unruly, disruptive, or illegal in nature.
- Intoxication or other signs of alcohol impairment that results in irresponsible behavior.
- Foul or abusive language or obscene gestures.
- Interference with the progress of the game (including throwing objects onto the field).
- Failing to follow instructions of stadium personnel.
- Verbal or physical harassment of opposing team fans.

SECURITY

To report misbehavior at the game, call 267-570-4444 or open a blank text message and address the message to 78247, type the word ASSIST followed by a space, then the issue (question, comment, concern) and seat location.

GAME DAY

The stadium entrances and when they open:

- **HeadHouse Plaza:** 3 hours before game
- **Clubs and suites:** 2 hours before game
- **Inner stadium gates:** 1 1/2 hours before game
- **Parking:** Lots are open 5 hours before game time. It's \$20 in lots at sports complex; \$40 for oversized vehicles.
- **SEPTA:** Eagles Express trains will run from Fern Rock every 10 minutes, starting at 10:10 a.m. and continuing until 12:10 p.m. for Sunday games and will stop at Olney, Erie, Girard, Spring Garden, Race-Vine, City Hall and Walnut-Locust. The ride to the stadium complex generally takes around 27 minutes from Fern Rock and 8 minutes from City Hall.
