

CRIME AT PUBLIC-HOUSING SITES

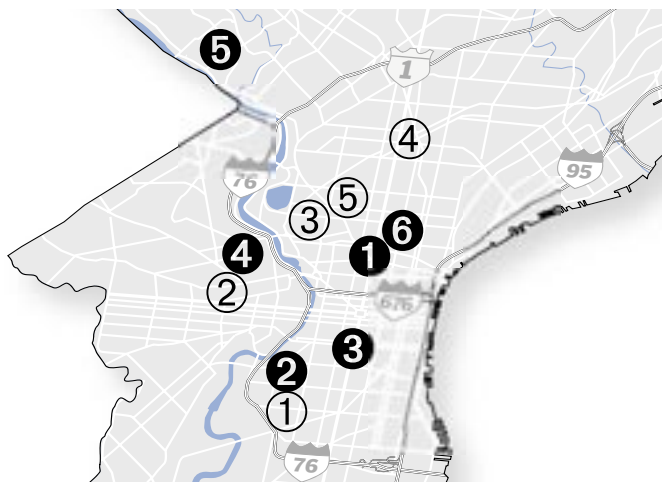
At all 45 PHA-run public-housing developments, the number of major crimes has jumped from 420 in 1999 to 693 in 2007, a 65 percent increase.

CRIME FALLS AT DEVELOPMENTS USING NEW DESIGN CONCEPTS ...

Crime has fallen significantly at each of six PHA developments rebuilt using new design concepts. Figures show number of major crimes.*

- 4** Norris Apartments, 2037 N. 11th St., North Philly: 58 major crimes
- 5** Raymond Rosen, 23rd and Diamond streets, North Philly: 48 major crimes
