KEVIN SMITH AND ADVISED THAT ON MAY 1, 2018, DURING A TRACK INVITATIONAL AT HADDONFIELD MEMORIAL HIGH SCHOOL, AN AFRICAN AMERICAN JUVENILE FEMALE ATHLETE WAS THE VICTIM OF A BIAS INCIDENT BY MEANS OF A RACIAL SLUR.</p> <p>PTL. SMITH STATED THAT THE JUVENILE REPORTED TO THE STERLING HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC DIRECTOR THAT SHE HAD BEEN STRETCHING ON THE TRACK ALONG WITH ANOTHER FEMALE ATHLETE FROM HADDON HEIGHTS HS, WHEN A CAUCASIAN HADDONFIELD HIGH SCHOOL LACROSSE ATHLETE SAID "MOVE NIGGER" AS HE WALKED PASSED THEM. THE DESCRIPTION OF THE SUSPECT WAS LIMITED BECAUSE HE WAS WEARING A HELMET. NO OTHER SUSPECT INFORMATION IS AVAILABLE. PTL. SMITH ALSO STATED THAT THE STERLING HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC DIRECTOR AND THE DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT WERE IN CONTACT WITH MR. LEFTERIS BANOS, HMHS ATHLETIC DIRECTOR, AND THE HADDONFIELD DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT. PTL. SMITH SAID THAT THE CAMDEN COUNTY PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE HAD BEEN ADVISED AND SUGGESTED THAT AN INVESTIGATION REPORT BE COMPLETED. HE ALSO SAID THAT THE VICTIM AND HER PARENTS ARE NOT INTERESTED IN PURSUING CHARGES ALTHOUGH THEY EXPECT THE RESPECTIVE SCHOOL TO HANDLE THE MATTER INTERNALLY.</p> <p>DSGT. 51. Narrative

On 5/7/18, Cpl. Ortiz notified me of a biased incident report that he had received from Somerdale Police. See initial report for additional details. Upon reviewing the initial report, I contacted CCPO Major Crimes to make notification as per protocol. I spoke to Det. McKeown and briefed him on the incident. He advised me that once the Biased Incident Supplement report was completed, a copy is to be forwarded to CCPO.

I notified Cpl. Ortiz to complete the Biased Incident Supplemental report. On 5/8/18, the Biased Incident Supplemental Report was approved and e-mailed to CCPO Major Crimes Det. McKeown. Subsequent copies were forwarded to NJSP UCR Unit.

On 5/9/18, Chief Stuessy advised me that Haddonfield school district superintendent had called him and requested that the school be allowed to handle the incident. I contacted CCPO Det. McKeown and advised him of this request. He conferred with CCPO Major Crimes Det. Pete Longo and they stated turning the matter over to Haddonfield school district would be permissible. This was determined due to the victim's parent's wishes from the initial report and the school's desire to address the matter. I then advised Chief Stuessy of my conversation with CCPO Major Crimes detectives.

At this point, the incident will be handled by the Haddonfield school district with the consent of CCPO. This case will be closed pending any additional details or incidents.
