

Harrisburg Figures Charged Yesterday

All are accused of organizing or participating in a scheme to use state workers, on state time, for Democratic political races, and rewarding them with bonuses.



Mike Veon

Was a top House leader, alleged mastermind of scheme using hundreds of state workers; plan paid millions in bonuses.



Sean Ramaley

Beaver County lawmaker accused of holding a “no-work” state job arranged for him by Veon.



Michael Manzo

Former top aide to the House’s top Democrat; accused of coordinating scheme and hiring lover.



Rachel Manzo

House staffer; accused of helping run program using state workers for political campaigns. Wife of Michael Manzo.



Brett Cott

Campaign operative, former Veon staffer; allegedly a lead promoter “of using taxpayer funds for campaigns.”



Jeff Foreman

Top House Democratic attorney; allegedly did private law work on state time and helped run political program.



Annamarie Perretta-Rosepink

Was Veon staffer; allegedly directed illegal political work in Beaver County and received bonuses.



Patrick Lavelle

Served on Veon’s legislative staff; known as the “fund-raiser” for work raising political money on the job.



Scott Brubaker

Former top staffer at House Democratic Caucus; allegedly received illegal bonuses of up to \$15,200.



Jennifer Brubaker

Director of research for House Democrats; allegedly received illegal bonuses of up to \$17,750.



Stephen Keefer

Was computer expert for Democrats; charged with doing design work for illegal mailings.



Earl Mosley

Was director of personnel for House Democrats; allegedly received bonuses of up to \$11,445.
