The winners were named at a luncheon in Washington, D.C., on Thursday, Sept. 6. Cash awards are \$300 for first place and certificates for all winners. The competition received 250 entries worldwide. Competition was suspended in two categories: Best Food Feature in a Magazine and Best Food Multimedia Presentation.

Nancy J. Stohs, food editor at the *Milwaukee Journal Sentinel*, is chair of the competition. Other committee members include Susan O. Nicholson, R.D. L.D., Atlanta; and Greg Morago, food editor at the *Houston Chronicle*. AFJ, now in its 38th year, is a professional journalism association that encourages communication among professional writers specializing in all aspects of food and food-related journalism.

AFJ upholds and fosters professional ethical standards, attempts to increase knowledge about food and encourages and promotes a greater understanding of food news among fellow journalists and those who manage news dissemination organizations.
