

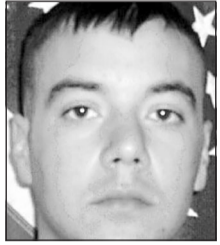
Killed in the Line of Duty

The names of 339 U.S. military service members have been added to the Iraqi war toll since *The Inquirer* last published the record in March 2008. *The Inquirer* has published the names and photos since April 2003. At least 4,331 Americans have died since March 2003.

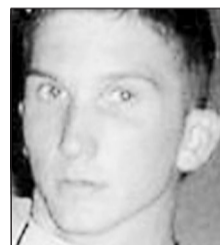

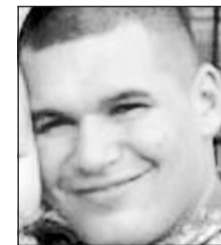

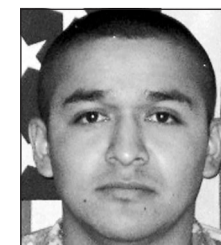
