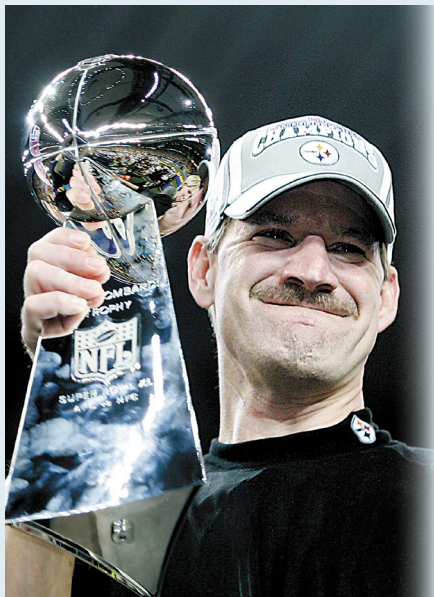


POSTSEASON SINCE 1961
