Directions

From points North or South: Take I-95 North or South to the I-676/US 30 exit (exit 22) towards Central Phila/Independence Hall. Keep right at the fork in the ramp. Merge onto Callowhill Street. Turn left onto North 4th Street. Turn right onto Vine Street. The Center is located at 501 Vine Street.

From NJ via the Ben Franklin Bridge: Take the 5th Street exit and go straight. You will see the Wood Turning Center directly in front of you.

From Route 676/Vine Street Expressway: Take the 8th Street exit, turn left onto Race Street and stay in the second lane from the right. Turn left onto 3rd Street. Turn left onto Vine Street. Go to 5th Street. WTC is on the right-hand corner.

Convenient free parking is available.
